Application Guidelines and Other Information:

- Applications must reach the CFOFO Scholarships & Awards Committee by **11:59 pm** on **April 1, 2018** (*no exceptions*).
- CFOFO will be awarding scholarships valued at \$500 each.
- Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements. Refer to application process below for a list of supporting documents required (i.e. reference letter, transcripts, passport-size photograph, etc.).
- Type or print legibly. Illegible application forms will be returned to the applicant. You may also download a copy of the application form online: www.cfofo.org.
- You will be notified by email in the first week of April regarding the status of your application. Interviews for successful applicants will be held on the second weekend of April.
- Applicant must be **under** 25 years of age as of December 31, 2018.
- Preference is given to applicants who have participated or volunteered in past or current CFOFO events. However, that is not the sole deciding factor and the scholarship is **open** to all applicants.
- Part-time studies (i.e. night school) programs/ correspondence courses do **not** qualify.
- Previous CFOFO Post-Secondary Scholarship Award winners do **not** qualify.
- The scholarship money will be paid directly to the individual upon proof of payment of tuition fees to a recognized post secondary institution for the 2017-2018 school year and completion of the two subjects below. Please note that funds **cannot** be issued before **October 1, 2018**.
- **Official Award Winners *must* participate in the 2018 CFOFO Summer BBQ Planning Committee.** Please contact CFOFO Awards Chairperson if you have any questions: info.cfofo@gmail.com
- Names of the successful applicants will be announced at the **Youth Talent Show on May 26, 2018. You MUST be present, *in person*, at the event in order to be *officially* awarded the scholarship.**

- c) Discuss the challenges facing youth in Canada whose parents are from countries such as Fiji.
- d) Discuss the challenges you believe that the Canadian youth of your generation are currently facing, will potentially face during their time in the workforce, and the keys to mitigating them.
